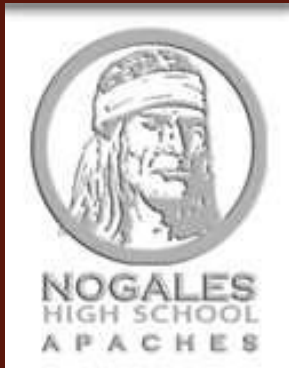

 - Or IB science options
- **History: 3 Years**
 - World History/Geography
 - U.S./AZ History
 - U.S. Government/Economics
- **Spanish** 1 Year (2 for university)
- **Physical Ed.** 1 Year
- **Fine Arts or/CTE** 1 Year
